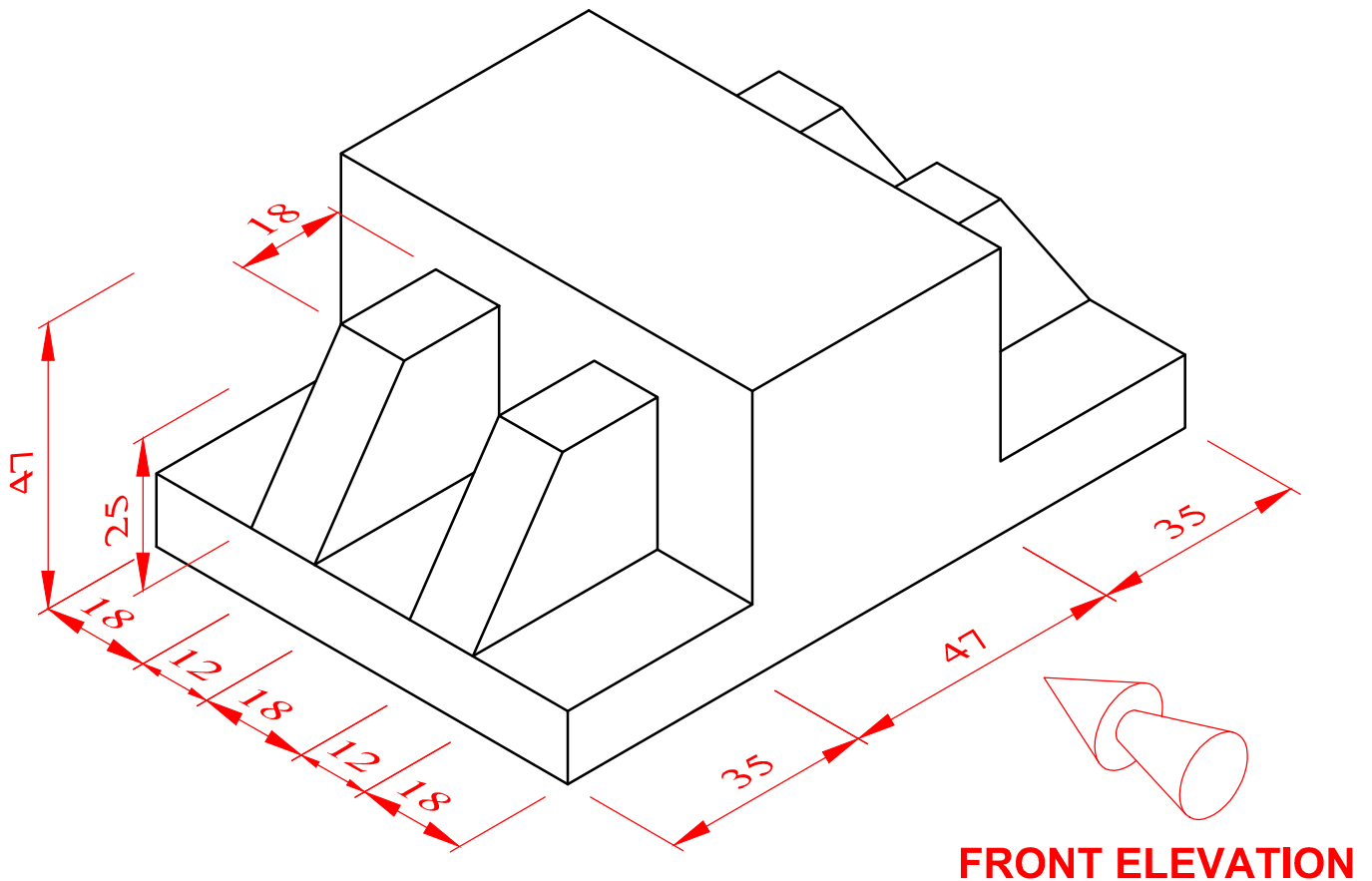


Third Angle Projection Exercise 11

To help you visualize the object better you can visit:

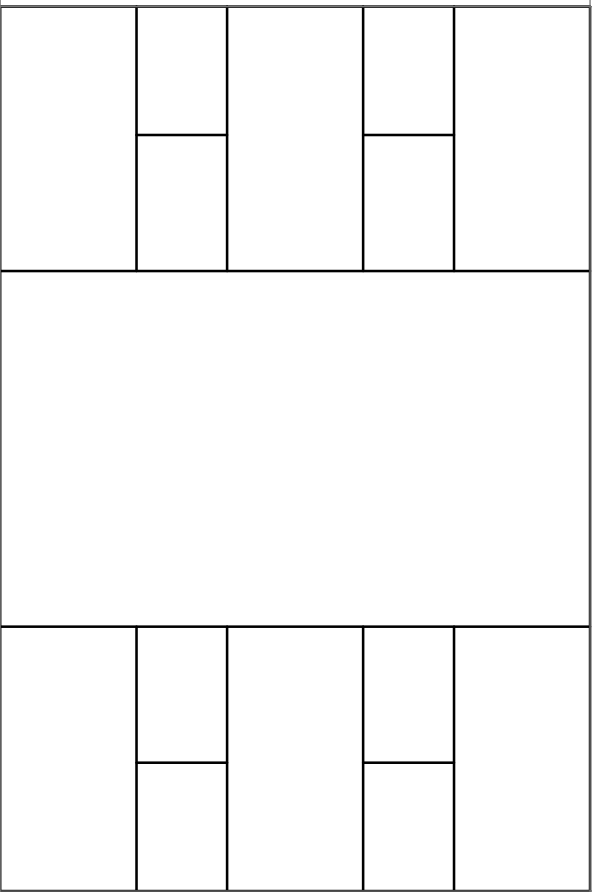
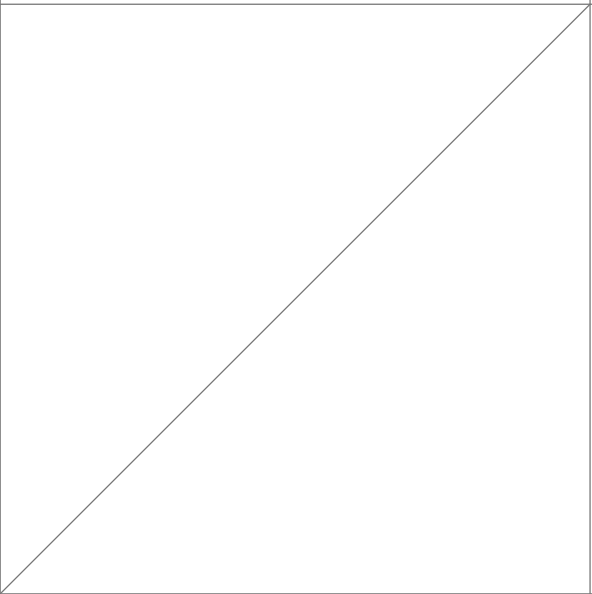
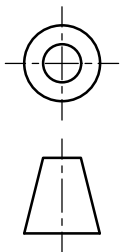
